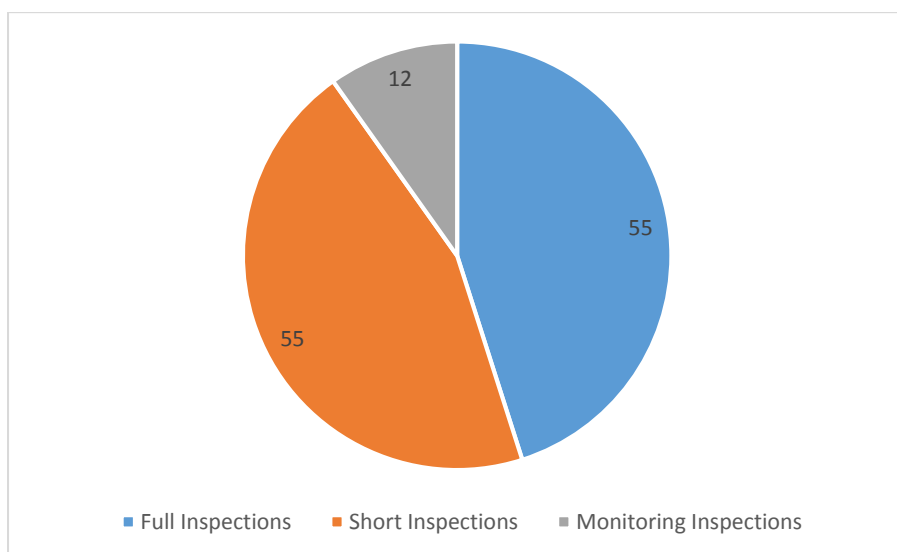

Since the doubling of the Primary PE and Sport Premium (PPSP), Ofsted have further strengthened their coverage of PE and the way in which schools have spent their PPSP. **87% of full inspections in 2017/18 investigated the effectiveness of the schools PPSP usage.**

Type of Inspection

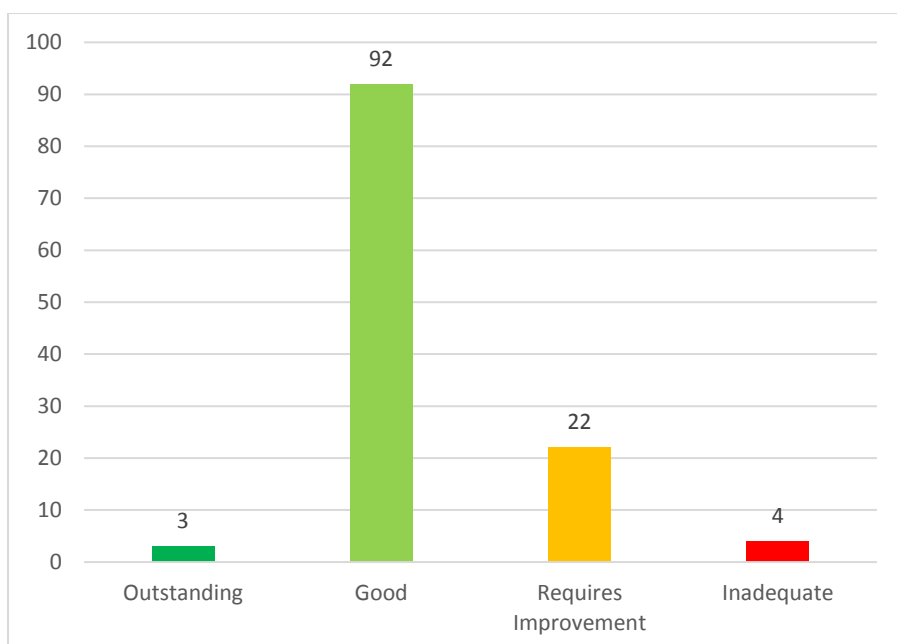


45% of schools visited by Ofsted had a full (section 5) inspection.

“Pupils understand about values such as fairness and respect. During sports day, they cheered on pupils who were on opposing teams.”

Judgements



Ofsted places the use of the PPSP funding under the ‘Effectiveness of leadership and management’.

“The school does not meet requirements on the publication of information about the curriculum, pupil premium funding, sports premium funding.” **(Inadequate)**

“Governors are aware that they do not evaluate the use of funding to check if it is making a difference to pupils’ outcomes.” **(Requires Improvement)**
